Reporting to the Maintenance Lead, and as part of the Lodi Gas Storage team, the Natural Gas Facility Instrumentation and Electrical Technician will ensure the safe, reliable, and efficient operation of the Gas Storage plant and field facilities. This position requires a self-motivated, hands-on individual with strong team skills.

This position is located in Acampo, California. All employees must reside within one hour of facility.

Primary Purpose of the Lodi Gas Storage Instrumentation and Electrical Technician role:

Supports the maintenance and testing of safety, instrumentation, and communication devices to ensure safe, reliable, and environmentally conscious operations of the Lodi Gas Storage facility.

Key Accountabilities: Include the following and other duties may be assigned.

- Responsible for maintenance, calibration, repair of all instrumentation, and electrical equipment.
- Maintain all plant and field processing equipment utilizing SCADA control systems.
- Maintain records and documentation for regulatory compliance
- Maintain annual device calibrations for the plant
- Respond to plant related emergencies when called upon to do so.
- Interface with SCADA team as needed.
- Understands and performs safety responsibilities such as hazard identification, equipment lockout, emergency response, implement safe work procedures, etc.
- Ensure effective communication with operations, maintenance, and management staff.
- Ongoing performance improvement including job progression, site-specific training, equipment training, etc.

Competencies:

All employees shall exhibit Lodi Gas Storage's values of being a Reliable, Safe, Environmentally Responsible, Low-Cost Provider, of showing and accepting Accountability, and being Entrepreneurial.

- Problem Solving and Decision Making - Organizes parts of a problem in a systematic and logical way in order to recognize relationships, identify alternative solutions, set priorities, and make sound decisions that align with Lodi Gas Storage's key values and guiding principles,
- Adaptability - Managing Change - Works efficiently in a constantly changing environment, demonstrating a willingness to learn, to take new and unique ideas, concepts, strategies, and approaches and apply them for positive results,
- Results Driven - Continually improves performance, approaching work in ways that support the accomplishment of results and meeting/exceeding Lodi Gas Storage's performance objectives.

Qualifications: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Education:

- High School Diploma or equivalent required.

Experience:

- 2+ years' experience in instrumentation and/or electrical equipment required.
- Gas storage experience a plus.
- Experience utilizing MS Office required.

Other skills, attributes, and abilities:

- In order to be successful in this position, one must possess a strong mechanical aptitude and excellent analytical skills.
- This position requires someone who can work well under pressure and has a strong commitment to safety.
- Individuals must have the knowledge and ability to analyze and solve operational problems to be successful in this type job. Good communication skills are required.
- Position supervises 24 hour, 365-day operation. It requires carrying a cell phone and being on-call most of the year. Normal and extraordinary work circumstances may often require without advance notice overtime after hours, on weekends, and holidays.

Physical Requirements in the role:

- The incumbent will spend the majority of their time in the field, thereby being exposed to adverse weather conditions, (heat, cold, wind), and hazardous environments. Must have good physical stamina to work long hours in the field.
- Must be able to comfortably climb ladders and stairs and work at heights.
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Must be able to work in confined spaces for up to one hour at a time.
- Must have the ability to walk on uneven ground for up to 2 miles during Pipeline activities.
- Must be able to work with hands below knees and or above shoulders for short periods of time up to 10 minutes.

- Field Environment

Other requirements:

- Successful completion of a pre-employment medical examination by a doctor selected by our company,
- Pre-employment Drug and Alcohol testing required,
- Satisfactory references regarding your work history and qualifications,
- Background check required,
- It is anticipated that you will be required to regularly operate a company vehicle for or on behalf of Lodi's business and you are required to hold and provide a copy of a valid driver's license and provide a copy of your driver's license abstract information.

- Please note: this position falls under regulation by the U.S. Department of Transportation, and as such will be subject to random drug testing according to DOT requirements.
